

Housatonic Community College



Diversified has been retained to provide FF&E coordination and relocation management services in relation to the additions and renovations of space in the adjacent former Sears Building. The new complex, now called Beacon Hall, consists of 174,500sf of space and will house three academic departments: Humanities, Business, and Behavioral & Social Sciences. It will include 30 classrooms, ten computer classrooms and special purpose rooms for computer repair and networks, early childhood education, labs for foreign languages, English as a second language and faculty offices. Also included within the new Beacon Hall is: a new college bookstore; a wellness center for aerobics, cardio and dance; and a satellite cafeteria.

Work to be completed in the year 2007 includes the Housatonic Community College's 200-seat Performing Arts Center (PAC). This performance area is to be completely renovated with new lighting grid and lights, sound controls and a state of the art modular, adjustable flooring system. This new flooring system will enable the PAC to be changed and modified into multiple seating and performance area configurations. The PAC space is used as a daily teaching space within the Housatonic Community College program, as well as a full performance theater with access and use by the public.
